McKinley L. Price, D.D.S.
Mayor, City of Newport News

The Honorable McKinley L. Price, DDS, is the Mayor of the City of Newport News, an office he has held since July 2010. Dr. Price is the first African American elected mayor in the City's history.

A native of Newport News, Dr. Price graduated from Huntington High School in 1967 and received his Bachelor of Arts degree in Biology from Hampton Institute (now Hampton University) in 1971. After being honorably discharged from the United States Army as 1st Lieutenant, he earned his Doctor of Dental Surgery degree from Howard University in Washington, D.C. and performed his general anesthesia residency at Provident Hospital in Baltimore, Maryland.

Dr. Price has received numerous honors and awards from many professional associations. In 1994, he received the President's Humanitarian Award from the Virginia Peninsula Chapter of 100 Black Men, who also recognized him as the Role Model of the Year in 2011. In 1996, he received the Presidential Citizenship Award from Hampton University. The Peninsula Chapter of the National Conference for Community and Justice presented him with their Humanitarian Award in 1996. In 1998, Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated honored him as Citizen of the Year. The Daily Press named him Citizen of the Year in 2005, highlighting his Co-Chairmanship of People to People, an organization committed to improving race relations in Newport News. Thomas Nelson Community College awarded him their TNCC Medallion in 2011 and he was named Outstanding Alumnus At Large by Hampton University in 2012.

In addition to the commitment he makes to his professional activities and successful dental practice, Dr. Price devotes untiring energy and time to his community. He served on the Newport News School Board from 1984 to 1992 and was appointed Chair for two years. He has served as Chairman of the Board for the Riverside Health System Foundation, Vice Chair of the Riverside Health System Board, and Chair of the Thomas Nelson Community College Board. Dr. Price was appointed by Governor Warner to the Virginia Economic Development Partnership Board and was appointed by Governor Terry McAuliffe to the Department of Medical Assistance Services Board. Dr. Price is currently the 1st Vice President for the African American Mayors Association and is on the Board of Directors for Delta Dental of Virginia.

Dr. Price is married to Valerie Scott Price, a retired educator and active community volunteer. They have two adult children and one grandson: McKinley II, DDS (Lenny), an Oral and Maxillofacial surgeon, wife, Amy, and their son, Asa, reside in Brooklyn; and daughter Marcia, is the 95th District Delegate in the Virginia House of Delegates.
